World Soil Day and Agriculture Education Day Celebrated at ICAR-IISS, Bhopal

Soil degradation has assumed serious proportion in our country, and as per the estimates about 104 million hectares of land area faces one or other form of soil degradation. In addition, agriculture sector is facing the threat of climate change. In this context, Soil Health Awareness Programme is being celebrated at ICAR-Indian Institute of Soil Science (IISS), Bhopal during December 04-06, 2023. World Soil Day (WSD) celebrated every year by Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations on 5th December. This years' theme of WSD is "Soil and Water, a source of life".
