

Training-cum-Input Distribution Programme of ICAR-IISS Bhopal “Biofertilizers for Improving Soil Health and Crop Production” at Betul District of Madhya Pradesh



ICAR-Indian Institute of Soil Science, Bhopal (M.P.) organised a training-cum-input distribution program “Biofertilizers for Improving Soil Health & Crop Production” for the tribal farmers of Betul district (M.P.) during 15-16 March, 2021. Beneficiaries of the programme was mainly 200 farmers from six tribal villages of the district viz., Charban, Chhata, Selagaon, Kahnegaon, Ghisi and Bagla. Other than imparting knowledge on how to use bioformulations for enhancing plant nutrition as well as for the management of soil born pest and diseases, the institute provided twelve different biofertilizers to the participants.



The programme was organized in different villages of the district with the help of Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Betul. ICAR-IISS Scientists Drs. Sanjay Srivastava, Shinogi K.C., Abhijith Sarkar, and Madhumonti Saha along with the KVK officials Drs. V.K. Verma (Programme Coordinator) and Sanjeev Verma coordinated the two days programme. Also, farmers were made aware of the Covid appropriate behaviour and face masks were also distributed to the participant farmers.
