4 December 2020 - The King Bhumibol World Soil Day Award was conferred to the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)-Indian Institute of Soil Science, Bhopal for its commitment to raising awareness of the importance of healthy soils. Particularly during last year's World Soil Day celebration which addressed soil erosion under the motto "Stop soil erosion, save our future". Her Royal Highness, Princess MahaChakriSirindhorn of Thailand, will give the award. The ceremony will take place in Bangkok in 2021 where the Princess will officially offer the prize to ICAR-IISS, India.

In this capacity, ICAR oversees one of the largest networks of agricultural research and education institutes in the world, covering the whole country in the fields of horticulture, soil science, fisheries and animal sciences among others.
